
National Overview and State Context

What is NCI?

- NCI is a voluntary effort by public developmental disabilities agencies to measure and track their own performance.
- Collaboration coordinated by HSRI and NASDDDS began in 1997
- Currently 46 states and Washington D.C. represented plus 22 sub-state entities

*Includes sub-state entities




NCI Goals

- Establish a nationally recognized set of performance and outcome indicators for DD service systems
- Use valid and reliable data collection methods & tools
- Report state comparisons and national benchmarks of system-level performance

- CMS Waiver Requirements
- Quality Assurance/Improve Services
- State by State Comparisons
- Assist with Community Transition
- Quality and DD Councils
- Reports to State Legislatures

System Performance

In-Person Survey

- Face-to-face meeting with person receiving services (at least one beyond case management)
- Three parts of the survey:
 - Background information demographics and personal characteristics (information mainly comes from records)
 - Section I subjective questions only person can answer
 - Section II objective questions can be answered by a proxy if needed



Response Rates

- 66.1% valid Section I
 - Up 5% from 2016-17!
- 99.8% valid Section II
- 969 total survey complete










Race by Region

- 0% family home


Problems with roommates*


Rights and Respect








Has Employment As Goal In Service Plan

Recap – In-Person Survey

- 50% of people lived in family home
- Nearly all reported they like their home
- Most reported taking active part in service planning meeting
- Significantly lower rates of:
 - Employment
 - Engagement in job-related activities
 - Employment goal in service plan
