The Department of Children and Families received the Florida Department of Law Enforcement results on the above named individual, as required by law, for juveniles (12-18), volunteers or 5 year re-screening for employees in caretaker positions or departmental positions of special trust or responsibility. Nothing was found that would disqualify the above-named individual from working in the program or profession for which you requested screening or for residing in a home that provides services to children or vulnerable adults. The results are valid only for the position for which you requested screening results.

This establishes the minimum standards for good moral character for any person required to undergo this screening. The employer has the final decision regarding selection considering all available information and the standards of the agency or employer that requested screening.

Criminal history information received by the department for the purpose of licensure or adoption will be forwarded to the Licensing Entity/Regulatory Authority so that an informed decision can be made by that Authority.

This screening is valid for five years from the "results date" above unless the individual has a 90-day break in service. However, the screening is no longer valid if a disqualifying offense is committed after the "Results Date" found above.
