

# WiSCC TOOL TRAINING

The following are some of the more significant changes with the WiSCC Tool:

- Shift in language to “Person”; Reviewer vs. Consultant; Findings vs. Scoring, etc.
- Moved satisfaction with services statements from Element 1 to Element 4.
- Language added concerning documentation needed for each determination of Achieving, Implementing, Emerging, and Not Emerging.
- Strengthened language in majority of Findings.
- Element 2 has an Alert.
- Element 3 states there is an effective use of POMs not just a piece of paper in the file.
- Element 3 strengthens WSC activities prior to the Support Plan.
- Element 4 now addresses satisfaction with services.
- Element 4 references aggregate information to address barriers.
- Element 5 does not have a lot of major changes.
- Element 6 references aggregate data and Projected Service Outcome or PSOs.
