

How is my Qlarant PDR CDC Score Calculated?

Consumer Directed Care (CDC+)

Representative PDR Tool

The Overall PDR CDC score is based on results from the Service Specific Record Review (SSRR) score.

- The SSRR score is scored on the Representatives record for the CDC+ Participant they work with.
- For CDC+ Representatives serving more than one participant, paperwork for up to two participants is reviewed.
- SSRR standards are worth 1, 2, or 3 points:
 - Health & Safety related standards are worth 3 points.
 - Person Centered related standards are worth 2 points.
 - Other basic requirement standards are worth 1 point.

*Standards that do not apply to the record are marked Not Applicable (NA). Standards marked NA are not included in your score. Each time a standard is marked NA, the total number of points possible for the record gets smaller.

ALERTS

Some standards can result in a Background Screening or Clearinghouse Roster Alert.

5 points are subtracted from your PDR Score for each type of alert.

Note: No more than 15 points can be subtracted from your PDR Score for Alerts.
